This class will explore leadership training, creativity and autonomy in a Theatrical Production, an extensive study in Theatrical History, and so much more.

This class will include:

- Theater 201 Study in Theatrical History, deeper dive into the aspects of a production, extended vocabulary, and deeper Shakespeare/Stanislavsky's study.
- The Art of Stage Marketing We will develop the "marketable skills" of publicity, programs, and sponsorships, social media, video, and more.
- The Art of the Audition Students will have the opportunity to participate in an audition. And will audition for the Spring Show.
- The Art of Leadership Opportunities to perform the roles of SM, TD, AD, Producer, or Director through leading the TA1 fall production/class performance.
- The Art of Purpose Learning through doing. Gaining a better understanding of their Christian Worldview in relation to the implementation of the Fine Arts.
